



RESOLUTION NO. 2026-049

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH DALLAS AREA RAPID TRANSIT AUTHORITY (DART) FOR FUNDING ALLOCATIONS AND GRANTS FROM DART TO THE CITY FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM AND COMPLEMENTARY TRANSPORTATION SERVICES IMPROVEMENTS AND PROJECTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City staff and city attorneys for multiple service area cities within the Dallas Area Rapid Transit Authority's (DART's) service area have discussed and negotiated a form interlocal agreement between each City and DART in furtherance of the General Mobility Program (GMP), wherein DART agrees to consider, approve and provide contributory funding for eligible City transportation projects for Public Transportation System and Complementary Transportation Services, which are transportation-related projects that are mutually beneficial to both DART and service area cities; and

WHEREAS, the City and DART have operated under a similar GMP funding arrangement for the past six years and desire to continue under a substantially similar arrangement for the ensuing six years; and

WHEREAS, the General Mobility Program funding and the City's participation in the GMP program are in the City's and the public's best interests; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that it is in the public interest to accept and approve the Interlocal Agreement between DART and the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, incorporated in and made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The Interlocal Agreement between DART and the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, for General Mobility Program Funds, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A, be and is hereby approved and accepted, and the City Manager is authorized to execute the Agreement on the City's behalf, to participate in the GMP program in applying for and seeking funding from the Dallas Area Rapid Transit Authority for eligible projects pursuant to the Interlocal Agreement, and to agree to such changes and amendments as the City Manager determines to be reasonable and necessary in compliance with state law and city policies.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
