Pavement Assessment




What is the pavement assessment?

- Pavement scan on all city roads and paved alleys for a total of 418 lane miles.
- The pavement scan will assist by supporting a data-driven approach to assess the condition of the City's streets in the form of a pavement condition index (PCI).
- The PCI index ranges from 0 (worst) to 100 (best).

Possible scores


- 86-100: Excellent condition, minimal to no repairs needed
- 71-85: Good condition, preventive maintenance may be required
- 56-70: Fair condition, showing signs of wear and tear, minor repairs may be needed
- 41-55: Poor condition, likely requires resurfacing or substantial repairs
- 0-40: Very poor condition, generally warrants complete reconstruction

PCI Rating Map




PCI Results
