Background:

- A master drainage study is a long-term plan that evaluates stormwater needs and flood risks



Purpose:

- The study will recommend flood mitigation improvements, estimate costs, prioritize projects, and support grant funding to guide cost-effective planning that protects public health and safety.



Study locations:

- Rawhide Creek from Valley View Lane to Webb Chapel Road
- The Zone A upstream extents of Farmers Branch Creek
- The Maybrook Channel
- Bee Street culvert crossing at Cooks Creek
- Stream 6H1 (Winn Park/Midway Road area)



Fiscal Impact:

- The amount of the Professional Services Agreement is \$302,500. Funds are available in the Public Drainage Projects CIP project in the Stormwater Capital Improvement Program Fund.
