


Construction of Erosion Control Project along Reach 4 of the Farmers Branch Creek

2019

 On June 19, 2019, Freese and Nichols presented a project prioritization list for Farmers Branch Creek. The list identified erosion repair projects needed to stabilize the creek. City Council directed staff to proceed with designing and constructing these repairs using a "reach concept," grouping projects by creek sections that impacted multiple properties. 2022

 On January 4, 2022, City Council approved a professional services agreement with Nathan D. Maier Consulting Engineers, Inc., for the design of these improvements identified as Reach 4. 2025

 On March 14, 2025, City Staff received the 100% plans for the erosion control of Reach 4 allowing staff to move forward with the construction portion of this project.

- The Engineer's Opinion of Probable Construction Cost (OPCC) for this project is \$1,900,000. On April 21, 2025, the City received five bids for the construction of this phase of the project. Stoic Civil Construction submitted the lowest bid, meeting all requirements, in the amount of \$1,800,000. The five received bids were:
 - Stoic Civil Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$1,800,000
 - Austin Filter Systems, Inc. in the amount of \$1,849,184
 - SJ&J Construction, LLC in the amount of \$1,937,634
 - Klutz Construction, LLC in the amount of \$1,954,354
 - TREG Erosion Control Specialists, LLC in the amount of \$3,082,290
