Solid Waste Services Overview

- Garbage and Recycling Collection - contracted service (CWD)
 - Garbage - 2/wk collection
 - Carts
 - Bags
 - Recycling – 1/wk
- Brush and bulk collection – City staff
 - Brush collection is weekly: same day as recycling – taken to contractor for mulching
 - Bulk – once per month: first full week of the month; same day as recycling
- Citizens Collection Center (CCC)
 - Bulky items
 - Recycling
 - Trash
 - Food Waste

Camelot Landfill

- Owned by the City of Farmers Branch
- Opened in 1981
- Major permit amendment completed in 2018
- Operated by Republic Services (Camelot TX LP)
 - Construct cells
 - Procure waste contracts
 - Responsible for all operational and compliance activities except landfill gas collection system installation
 - Sets disposal rates
 - City is paid 16% of gross revenue
 - Must accept residential waste from City at no cost.
- Total Permitted Area: 459.8 acres
- Max Elevation: 765 msl
- Total capacity: 53,200,000 cy
- Remaining capacity: 25,717,964 cy
- Estimated life span: 14 years (varies year to year)
