

Are we allowed to negotiate separate delivery and any other accessorial fees to entities outside of TARRANT county directly? Or are we allowed this **only** if they are not in Tarrant, Dallas, Denton and Collin Counties?

RESPONSE:

Awarded vendor is only allowed to negotiate delivery charges for entities outside of Tarrant, Dallas, Denton and Collin County.

76. What is the contract start and end date for this RFB?

GLOSSARY OF TERMS

Fuel

Reformulated Gasoline (RFG) – is gasoline blended to burn more cleanly than conventional gasoline and to reduce smog-forming and toxic pollutants in the air we breathe. The RFG program was mandated by Congress in the 1990 Clean Air Act amendments. The first phase of the RFG program began in 1995 and the second (current) phase began in 2000.

E85 – an abbreviation typically referring to an ethanol fuel blend of 85% denatured ethanol fuel and 15% gasoline or other hydrocarbon by volume.

Ultra-Low-Sulfur Diesel (ULSD) – is diesel fuel with substantially lowered sulfur content. Since 2006, almost all of the petroleum-based diesel fuel available in Europe and North America has been of a ULSD type.

Texas Low Emission Diesel (TxLED) – must contain no more than 10 percent aromatic hydrocarbons by volume and must have a cetane number of 48 or greater, or else must use an approved alternative formulation or comply with the designated alternative limits.

Soy Methyl Ester (SME)

Government Agencies

Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) – is an agency of the United States federal government whose mission is to protect human and environmental health. The EPA is responsible for conducting environmental assessment, research and education to create and enforce standards and laws that will promote the health of individuals and the environment.

Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) – is the environmental agency for the State of Texas.

Organizations

Oil Price Information Service (OPIS) – is a company providing pricing and news information for petroleum pricing, news and analysis for gasoline, diesel, ethanol, biodiesel, LP-gas, jet fuel, crude, natural gas, refinery feedstocks, residual fuel, and kerosene.

ASTM International (ASTM) – is an international standards organization that develops and publishes voluntary consensus technical standards for a wide range of materials, products, systems, and services. Formerly known as the American Society for Testing and Materials.

Miscellaneous

Leaking Underground Storage Tank Trust Fund (LUST) – Congress created the Leaking Underground Storage Tank Trust Fund in 1986 by amending Subtitle I of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

I. PURPOSE

A. Tarrant County is requesting bids for the Annual Contract for the purchase of various types of fuel on an as needed basis including the following:

Reformulated Gasoline (RFG)

E85 Gasoline

TxLED No. 2 Diesel

Red Dyed Diesel

- B. Should fuels offered by vendor not fall within these specifications, the variances must be stated in bid response and Tarrant County reserves the right to accept or reject the bid if the variances are considered excessive.
- C. Including participation of member entities through the Tarrant County Cooperative, approximately 4.3 million gallons of fuel was purchased through this agreement from April 2022 through December 2022.

II. FUEL PRODUCTS

- A. All fuels delivered under this agreement must not contain any foreign substances or water, which may damage any Tarrant County or participating entities vehicles or cause contamination of fuel storage tanks.
- B. The awarded vendor(s) must provide fuels that comply with the most current state and federal legislation requirements through the entire agreement term.
- C. The awarded vendor(s) will be responsible for adhering to all current and any new legislation, rules, laws and/or other requirements pertaining to in-ground fuel deliveries.
- D. Reformulated Gasoline:
 - 1. RFG must contain additive package and corrosion inhibitors.
 - If product package and/or corrosion inhibitor are changed or altered, the new formulation must meet and/or exceed the federal government and/or TCEQ standards.
 - 3. All products must meet ASTM D5798-17 Standards and Specifications regarding sampling and testing requirements.

E. Diesel:

- 1. TxLED fuel must contain approved TCEQ Additives.
- 2. TxLED fuel must not contain more than 5% biodiesel additive.

F. Testing:

1. Deliveries of fuel under this contract are subject to testing, to insure compliance with specifications.

- Testing will be conducted at Tarrant County's expense.
- When test analysis shows fuel does not meet specification, vendor shall be solely responsible for all repairs and cleaning necessary to satisfactorily restore contaminated tanks and equipment. If necessary to restore contaminated tanks and equipment vendor is solely responsible for the pumping out of contaminated fuel and the replacement of compliant fuel at no additional cost to Tarrant County.

III. DELIVERY

- A. Deliveries will be made to the various locations Monday through Friday during normal business hours of 6:00 AM 5:00 PM. Any orders placed outside of normal business hours are subject to an additional fee as provided on the Price Form.
- B. It is the responsibility of the awarded vendor(s) to deliver fuel by their own means within forty-eight (48) hours after receipt of order (ARO).
- C. A delivery slip must be included with each delivery made.
- Title and risk of loss of fuel must not pass to Tarrant County until Tarrant County takes possession of fuel at point of delivery.
- Fuel Load Sizes:
 - 1. Pricing must be based on the fuel type and load size.
 - 2. The following fuel load sizes will apply.

a. Transport Load: 7,500 gallons or more

b. Short Transport Load: 4,000 gallons to 7,499 gallonsc. Tank Wagon Load: 1,500 gallons to 3,999 gallons

d. Short Tank Wagon Load: 1,499 gallons or less

Awarded vendor(s) must allow combining quantities of various types of fuels to be delivered to one (1) location at the same time in order to take advantage of the better pricing for transport loads.

For Example: If a location needs 4,000 gallons of RFG regular and 4,000 gallons of diesel both items can be combined for a total of 8,000 gallons which is a Transport Load. Both fuels would then receive pricing for a Transport Load.

- 1. Location is defined as the same physical address. This includes but is not limited to two (2) deliveries to one (1) location for the same delivery.
- 2. Additional charges are not allowed.
- G. Split Loads:
 - 1. Charges for split loads are NOT authorized in this Bid.
 - 2. A split load is defined as two (2) or more deliveries to the same location on the same day to two (2) or more fuel tanks.
- H. Tarrant County and participating entities reserve the right to add and/or delete delivery locations during the course of this agreement.

Awarded vendor must fill emergency generators at no additional cost to Tarrant County. The filling of generator may be for quantities as small as one (1) to two (2) gallons. This may require the use of a hand canister to complete the service.

IV. NONDELIVERY NOTIFICATION

A. Awarded vendor must notify requestor if scheduled delivery will not be made within 24 hours of the scheduled delivery time.

V. BID PRICING

- A. Vendors MUST bid on all items to be considered for award.
- B. Bid pricing must be based on a +/- differential based on the Dallas Metro, Texas OPIS (Rack Average) (Oil Price Information Service) Petrostat net price sent at 10:00 a.m. EST for the date the fuel is delivered.
 - 1. The Price Form requires the vendor to write the word plus or minus for each item. This is done to prevent confusion and to allow for clarity.
 - 2. The written word will prevail over the math symbol of +/-.
- C. All prices for this agreement must include the delivery cost to any designated area within Tarrant, Dallas, Denton and Collin County. This section supersedes what is listed in the Tarrant County Cooperative Purchasing section listed in the RFB.

VI. ESTIMATED QUANTITIES

- A. While the entities listed as co-operative member entities are allowed to participate in Tarrant County's bid for fuel, they are NOT obligated to purchase fuel from this bid once awarded.
- B. Other entities that are located within Tarrant, Dallas, Denton and Collin Counties will have the option to join this bid at the same pricing terms and conditions.
- C. Entities located outside these counties may join but the delivery charges, if any, should be negotiated between the awarded vendor(s) and each entity.
 - 1. Vendors should take into consideration the combined quantities and the potential quantities from other entities when bidding.
 - 2. All quantities listed herein are estimates only, therefore not guaranteed.

VII. TAXES AND FEES

- A. Federal Excise Tax:
 - Tarrant County and any other participating entities that fall into these guidelines, in accordance with Internal Revenue Service standards, are exempt from paying federal excise tax on fuels.
 - 2. Tarrant County and any other participating entities if applicable will sign a certificate of exemption, to be maintained on file with the awarded vendor(s) for the duration of the agreement

- B. The following Taxes and Fees are considered allowable charges as there are no exemptions at this time:
 - a. State of Texas Motor Fuel Tax
 - b. State of Texas Product Delivery Fee
 - c. Federal LUST Fee
 - d. Federal Oil Spill Liability Fee

VIII. OPIS SUBSCRIPTION

A. Tarrant County and participating entities shall be responsible for obtaining, paying for and maintaining a subscription to OPIS in order to confirm invoiced pricing. Participating entities will be responsible for paying their own subscription.

IX. TANK MONITORING SYSTEM

A. Tarrant County prefers a vendor who can provide a tank monitoring system, i.e., SmartTank Technology or an approved equal. Tank monitoring shall be provided at no additional cost to Tarrant County.

X. ORDER PLACEMENT

- A. Tarrant County orders will be placed by email or telephone requesting specific delivery dates, quantities and locations by a designated representative from each department. A purchase order number must be provided at that time.
- B. Participating entities will have their own designated representatives and methods of requesting delivery dates, quantities, locations and tracking of orders.
