



RESOLUTION NO. 2025-189

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH WEAVER CONSULTANTS GROUP, LLC FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING AND SURVEYING SERVICES RELATING TO PHASE H OF THE LANDFILL GAS COLLECTION SYSTEM EXPANSION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$220,408; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City owns Camelot Landfill, which is equipped with an active landfill gas collection and control system; and

WHEREAS, the existing gas collection and control system is in need of expansion in order to control greenhouse gas emissions and comply with the New Source Performance Standards; and

WHEREAS, the City previously contracted with the predecessor to Weaver Consultants Group to provide professional engineering and surveying services associated with the expansion of the landfill gas collection system, and the City Administration desires and recommends the engagement of Weaver Consultants Group to perform the design and construction services for the next phase of the system; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch finds it in the public interest to concur in the foregoing recommendation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and sign on behalf of the City of Farmers Branch an agreement with Weaver Consultants Group, LLC for professional engineering and surveying services relating to the design and construction services for Phase H of the Camelot Landfill Gas Collection System, with the cost of such services not to exceed \$220,408.00 and to sign such change orders with respect to said contract as the City Manager determines to be in the public interest and in compliance with applicable city policy and state law.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage.
