



RESOLUTION NO. 2026-082

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH DALLAS UNDERGROUND, LLC., FOR THE WEBB CHAPEL ROAD WATER AND WASTEWATER IMPROVEMENTS PHASE 2 PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,695,813.00; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE APPROPRIATE AGREEMENTS AND PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT ON THE CITY'S BEHALF; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City Administration, determining that certain water and sewer improvements were necessary, sought and obtained competitive bids for the construction of the Webb Chapel Road Water and Wastewater Improvements Phase 2 (the Project); and

WHEREAS, after reviewing responsive bids received for the Project, Dallas Underground, LLC., of Dallas, Texas, submitted the lowest bid in the amount of \$2,695,813, and provided a satisfactory statement of qualifications and list of references; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that Dallas Underground, LLC., has submitted the lowest qualified bid for the Project, and accepting the bid is in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council approves, and the City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute, a construction contract with Dallas Underground, LLC., for the construction of the Webb Chapel Road IH-635 to Veronica Lane and Selma Lane to Valley View Lane Water and Wastewater Improvements Phase 2 Project pursuant to the bid and contract documents attached hereto as Exhibit "A," in an amount not to exceed \$2,695,813.00.

SECTION 2. The City Manager is authorized to provide for payment and to sign on the City's behalf any necessary or appropriate documents and to accept and approve such change orders or contract amendments as the City Manager deems reasonable, necessary, in the public interest, in compliance with applicable law and City policy, and, in the case of an increase in contract price, subject to the availability of funds.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall be effective immediately after final passage.
