

West Side Art Trail Phase 1

Overview/Background

- Identified need for connectivity to the City's west side in 2015 Trails Master Plan
- 2 Entirety of West Side Art Trail to be completed in two phases
- Phase 1 Highlights: Provides safe passage under I-35, and to Irving's Campion Trail
- Developers on the west side are building sections of the trail as part of their project construction

Trail Alignment

The yellow sections represent portions of the trail that are to be completed in Phase 1

East of I-35:

- From the DART Station, south on Denton Dr
- West along Rawhide Creek (Dallas Water Utilities property)
- South on I-35 Service
 Rd/Harry Hines Blvd under
 I-35 to Morgan Pkwy

West of I-35:

- From Mercer Pkwy, southwest along Valley View Ln to I-635 Service Rd
- I-635 Service Rd connection at Campion Trail








Opinion of Probable Construction Cost (OPCC) \$5,558,001

West Side Art Trail Phase 1

Funding Mechanisms Total \$7,568,454

- Dallas County \$1.5M match
- 2 Federal Funds via TxDOT \$4,545,725 reimbursable grant
- City's Monetary Contributions \$1.5M Dallas County match, \$22,729 (paid in 2021 to TxDOT)
- City's Non-Monetary Contributions*

 Transportation Development Credits (TDCs) used in lieu of 20% financial participation

*City avoids \$909,145 cash match by using TDCs, allowing federal funds to cover most or all project costs, minimizing or eliminating City contribution
