

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-060



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH FREESE AND NICHOLS, INC. FOR PHASE 4 OF THE LEAD AND COPPER RULE REVISION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$120,133.00; AUTHORIZING ITS EXECUTION BY THE CITY MANAGER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, and Freese and Nichols, Inc. have negotiated a proposed Professional Services Agreement for Phase 4 of the Lead and Copper Rule Revision (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, City Administration has determined that Freese and Nichols, Inc. is the most qualified to perform the services necessary for the Project, recommends approving an agreement with Freese and Nichols, Inc. for the Project; and

WHEREAS, upon full review and consideration of the proposed Professional Services Agreement and all matters related thereto, the City Council is of the opinion and finds that the terms and conditions thereof should be approved and that the City Manager, or designee, should be authorized to enter into and approve the Agreement on behalf of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to approve and execute the Professional Services Agreement between the City of Farmers Branch and Freese and Nichols, Inc. for Phase 4 of the Lead and Copper Rule Revision in an amount not to exceed \$120,133.00, and is further authorized to accept and approve such additional change orders and contract amendments as the City Manager deems reasonable, necessary, in the public interest, in compliance with applicable law and City policy, and, in the case of an increase in contract price, subject to the availability of funds.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
