Encampments

City faces complex challenges, especially under the bridges (DART & Roadways), and along shared borders with the City of Dallas.

Debris & Fecal Material

Debris & fecal material left in areas with high levels of unhoused individuals.

Safety concerns

Concerns about public safety for residents and staff across the city.

City Parks

Encampments or unhoused individuals in city parks.

- Liberty Plaza
- Joya Park



Bridges

Sites that are located under city roads or DART bridges.



Private or Abandoned Property

On private property across the city or on abandoned property.

Social Services

The City provides social services through Metrocrest Services. Metrocrest Services responds out to sites and individuals to offer resources and assistance.



Multi-City Coalitions

The City is working with two Multi-City groups to create a regional approach and working towards a more coordinated response.




Contracted Cleaning Service

The City utilizes a private contractor for general refuse removal. The contractor sweeps the city once every two weeks. Can also respond as needed in some situations as available.
