Please direct your comments to the Mayor. Each speaker will be limited to three (3) minutes. Speaker time may not be shared with, or reserved for, other speakers.

The City Council may not take specific action on any subject raised by a speaker during Citizen Comments. The City Council may: have the item placed on a future agenda for action; refer the item to the City Manager and/or staff for further study or action; briefly state existing City policy; or provide a brief statement of factual information in response to the inquiry.

H.1 ORD-3290 Conduct a public hearing and consider adopting Ordinance No. 3290 amending Planned Development No. 81 (PD-81) to allow a 10.58 acre "Mixed Use Residential" development including a Conceptual Site Plan, and take appropriate action. The proposed Conceptual Site Plan includes the development of approximately 448 multi-family units with several Special Exceptions. The site is located on the southwest corner of the intersection of the eastbound frontage road of the LBJ Freeway (I- 635) and Mira Lago Boulevard within PD-81, commonly known as 11771 Mira Lago Boulevard.

- H.2 <u>ORD-3291</u> Conduct a public hearing and consider adopting Ordinance No. 3291 amending Planned Development No. 88 (PD-88) establishing new freestanding monument sign requirements within the "Mid-Density Residential" subdistrict and take appropriate action.
- H.3 ORD-3292 Conduct a public hearing and consider adopting Ordinance No. 3292 to change the zoning on an approximate 25 acre tract from Planned Development No. 88 (PD-88) to Planned Development No. 97 (PD-97) and take appropriate action. This request includes a Conceptual Site Plan and a Special Exception for the development of light industrial and office land uses. This tract is located along the southbound frontage road of Stemmons Freeway (I-35East) approximately 180 feet south of Springlake Road, also known as 12301 and 12401 Stemmons Freeway.
