## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-113**



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF TEN CARGO/UTILITY TRAILERS FROM HAPPY TRAILER SALES IN THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$124,285; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE APPROPRIATE AGREEMENTS AND PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT ON THE CITY'S BEHALF; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City staff has determined, and the City Council concurs, that it is necessary to purchase and acquire cargo/utility trailers for the City's Parks and Recreation Department for landscaping and maintenance operations; and

WHEREAS, City staff has completed a competitive bidding process and has received one bid meeting specifications for the purchase of a total of ten cargo/utility trailers, and recommends the purchase of ten trailers from Happy Trailer Sales pursuant to Bid No. 24-28; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, upon full review and consideration of the proposed procurement and all matters related thereto, is of the opinion and finds that the quotes should be accepted and that the City Manager, or designee, should be authorized to accept the quotes and accomplish the purchase of the items described therein, which the Council finds and determines are in the best interests of the citizens of the City.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

**SECTION 1**: The City Council hereby approves the purchase of ten cargo/utility trailers from Happy Trailer Sales in the aggregate amount of \$124,285 pursuant to the quotes attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and authorizes the City Manager to: (1) accept and approve the purchase of the items in the foregoing amount, (2) provide for payment and to sign on the City's behalf any necessary or appropriate documents, and (3) accept and approve such contract amendments as the City Manager deems reasonable, necessary, in the public interest, in compliance with applicable law and City policy, and, in the case of an increase in contract price, subject to the availability of funds.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage as the law and charter in such cases provide.
