



**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-041**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT FOR A SCHOOL FLASHER BEACON SYSTEM UPGRADE FROM RADIO TO CELLULAR WITH CONSOLIDATED TRAFFIC CONTROLS, INC, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$112,670 FROM CONSOLIDATED TRAFFIC CONTROLS, INC, A SOLE SOURCE VENDOR; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, City Administration has identified the need to upgrade the school flasher beacon system throughout the City of Farmers Branch and has obtained a proposal for this project from Consolidated Traffic Controls, Inc, in the amount of \$112,670; and

**WHEREAS**, City Administration has reviewed the proposal from Consolidated Traffic Controls, Inc., which is a sole source vendor and exclusive distributor of the needed equipment and materials, and recommends the procurement; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it to be in the public interest to concur in the above recommendation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council approves the purchase of materials and equipment for the system upgrade and conversion from radio to cellular of the school flasher beacon system throughout the City from Consolidated Traffic Controls, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$112,670, in accordance with the quote attached hereto as Exhibit A and authorizes the City Manager to take such action to negotiate and execute such agreements as necessary or appropriate to contract, on behalf of the City, for system upgrades for the school flasher beacon system, including the authority to approve any necessary amendments and instruments related thereto on behalf of the City of Farmers Branch, subject to available funding.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
