

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-038



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, REAFFIRMING, APPROVING AND RATIFYING THE PURCHASE OF SIGNAL HEAD REPLACEMENT MATERIALS FROM CONSOLIDATED TRAFFIC CONTROLS, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$82,501.54; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE APPROPRIATE AGREEMENTS AND PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT ON THE CITY’S BEHALF; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City staff has determined, and the City Council concurs, that it is necessary to purchase and acquire signal head replacement materials and supplies for the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, City staff has selected Consolidate Traffic Controls, Inc., as an appropriate vendor for the purchase through a purchasing cooperative, HGACBuy Contract #PE-05-21; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, upon full review and consideration of the proposed procurement and all matters related thereto, is of the opinion and finds that the purchase should be accepted, reaffirmed and ratified and that the City Manager or designee, should be authorized to accept and accomplish the procurement described therein, which the Council finds and determines are in the best interests of the citizens of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Council approves, reaffirms and ratifies the procurement by the City Manager, who is hereby authorized to accept and approve the quote, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A,” from Consolidated Traffic Control, for the procurement of the items and services stated therein in an amount not to exceed \$82,501.54, and is further authorized provide for payment and to sign on the City’s behalf any necessary or appropriate documents and accept and approve such contract amendments as the City Manager deems reasonable, necessary, in the public interest, in compliance with applicable law and City policy, and, in the case of an increase in contract price, subject to the availability of funds.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage as the law and charter in such cases provide.
