Those individuals will be recognized during the meeting at the time the agenda item is presented.

Any individual who wishes to place an item on a future City Council agenda should fill out a Request for Future City Council Agenda Item card (also located in the back of the Council Chambers). Completed cards should be submitted to the City Secretary.

F. <u>CITIZEN COMMENTS</u>

The City Council invites citizens to speak to the City Council on any subject not listed on the City Council agenda. Any person who desires to address the City Council on such item shall complete and submit a Citizen Comments Registration Card to the City Secretary or City Administration prior to the start of the City Council meeting. Those individuals will be recognized by the Mayor during the meeting at the time the Citizen Comments Section is reached. When your name is called please approach the speaker's podium in the center of the Council Chambers, state your name and address for the record, and discuss the specific subject or topic of interest. Please direct your comments to the Mayor. Each speaker will be limited to three (3) minutes. Speaker time may not be shared with, or reserved for, other speakers.

The City Council may not take specific action on any subject raised by a speaker during Citizen Comments. The City Council may: have the item placed on a future agenda for action; refer the item to the City Manager and/or staff for further study or action; briefly state existing City policy; or provide a brief statement of factual information in response to the inquiry.
