LEED Background

Operated by U.S. Green Building Council

- Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED)
 - Widely used as rating system for green buildings
 - Nine buildings listed as LEED certified in Farmers Branch

Expanded to include a rating system for cities



LEED for Cities

- Rating system includes variety of categories:
 - Natural systems, transportation, water efficiency, energy and greenhouse gas emissions, materials and resources, quality of life, and others.

- Combination of adopted policies, programs, and practices to earn points towards certification
 - Adoption of a sustainable procurement policy
 - Percentage of residents within ½ mile walk to green spaces
 - Water usage in gallons per capita per day

Benefits

- Recognition for sustainability work
- National standard to compare to peer cities
- Gap analysis to identify areas of improvement
- Accelerator program for Texas cities and waived registration fee
