

 - 12th overall







Both Citizen Relief and Public Safety Investment:

Citizen Relief

- Approved \$100,000 each Senior and Disabled Persons Exemptions
- Water and Sewer Relief – Equal to 5-cent Reduction in Property Taxes
- Significant Investment in Infrastructure & Smart Meter Technology

Public Safety

- 5 Additional Police Personnel
- 1 Additional Fire Administrator
- 7% Across the Board Increases for Police and Fire
- Justice Center Upgrades
- 20 Year TMRS
