B. CITIZEN COMMENTS

Anyone wishing to speak shall be courteous and cordial. No disparaging or inflammatory remarks directed at any member of the Planning and Zoning Commission or City staff will be allowed.

The Planning and Zoning Commission is not permitted to take action on any subject raised by a speaker during Citizen Comments. However, the Planning and Zoning Commission may have the item placed on a future agenda for action; refer the item to the Director of Planning for further study or action; briefly state existing City policy; or provide a brief statement of factual information in response to the inquiry.
