

ORDINANCE NO. 3757

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CITY'S 2021-22 FISCAL YEAR OPERATING AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BUDGET AS AMENDED; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City of Farmers Branch, Texas, Ordinance No. 3698 adopted a budget for the City for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021, and ending September 30, 2022 (the "Budget"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas desires to amend the Budget to provide funds for expenses not originally anticipated at the time of adoption of the Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Budget of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021, and ending on September 30, 2022, as approved by Ordinance No. 3698 is hereby amended by transferring \$500,000 from the General Fund Reserves fund balance resulting from increased sales tax revenue and appropriating said amount to General Fund Non-Departmental division Special Projects account.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances of the City of Farmers Branch in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be, and the same are hereby, repealed and all other provisions of the Ordinances of the City of Farmers Branch not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this Ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof other than the part thereof decided to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, as the law and City Charter in such cases provide.
