ARTICLE V. - VEGETATION

Sec. 56-51. - Declared a public nuisance and prohibited.

It is unlawful and declared a public nuisance for any person, owner or tenant of any real property, occupied or unoccupied, to maintain any and all vegetation on such real property that fails to comply with the following provisions:

(e) Trees stumps located in the front yard and/or adjacent right-of-way of a premises shall be cut or ground to no higher than six inches above grade level. It shall not be a defense to this section 56-51(e) that the tree stump was created by the removal of a tree on or before August 3, 2021.
