






The 20 Neighborhood Areas



Financial Support*



10% match requirement

Cash, materials, labor, 3rd party donations

20% match requirement

Cash, materials, labor, 3rd party donations

30% match requirement

Cash, materials, labor, 3rd party donations

40% match requirement

Cash (at least half of the 40% match must be in cash), materials, labor, 3rd party donations

Maximum City exposure for any project is \$50,000.
