



RESOLUTION NO. 2017-075

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, CANVASSING AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE JUNE 10, 2017, RUNOFF ELECTION FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is hereby found and determined that notice of the election was duly given in the form, manner and time required by law, and said election was in all respects legally held and conducted in accordance with applicable laws of the State of Texas and the proceedings calling and governing the holding of such election; and

WHEREAS, it is imperative to consider the returns of the election held on June 10, 2017, for the purpose of electing the hereinafter named official; and

WHEREAS, the returns of said election have been duly and legally made and submitted to the City Council for canvassing, and a tabulation of the returns for the polling places and for early voting, as canvassed and tabulated by this governing body as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The said election was duly called, that notice of said election was given in accordance with the law, and that said election was held in accordance with the law, and that **Robert Dye**, having received the majority of the votes cast in said election, is hereby declared to be duly elected to the office of **Mayor**, subject to taking the oath of office as provided by the Constitution and laws of the State of Texas:

SECTION 2. It is further found and determined that in accordance with the order of this governing body, the City Secretary posted written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting on the bulletin board located at City Hall, a place convenient and readily accessible to the general public, and said notice having been so posted and remaining posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the scheduled time of said meeting.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
