



**RESOLUTION NO. 2017- 084**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, INCREASING THE NUMBER OF THE MUNICIPAL DRAINAGE UTILITY SYSTEM ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBERS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, previously adopted Resolution No. 2015-028 creating a Municipal Drainage Utility System Advisory Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to increase the number of members for Municipal Drainage Utility System Advisory Committee;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** Resolution No. 2015-028 is hereby amended by amending Section 1 thereof to increase the number of members of the Municipal Drainage Utility System Advisory Committee by one position to read as follows:

“There is hereby established a Municipal Drainage System Advisory Committee consisting of five (5) members appointed by the City Council for a term of two (2) years each of which two committee members shall be a resident of the City and/or a representative of a home owners association in the City; one member of the committee shall be appointed from and represent the business community of the City; one member of the committee shall be the then current Valwood Improvement Authority Executive Director; and one member of the committee shall be appointed from and be a representative of the construction and development industry in the City. One member of the City Council shall be appointed by the City Council to serve as a non-voting ex-officio member of the committee. The Public Works Director or designee shall serve as the City staff liaison to the committee.”

**SECTION 2.** Resolution No. 2015-028 shall remain in full force and effect, except as amended herein.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its approval.
