RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE DALLAS COUNTY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT FUNDING AGREEMENT WITH DALLAS COUNTY RELATIVE TO THE WESTSIDE TRAIL PROJECT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in May 2016, the City and Dallas County ("the County") entered into a Capital Improvement Project Funding Agreement ("Funding Agreement") to provide funds and set out other agreements relating to the construction of a multi-modal trail facility relative to the City's Westside Trail Project ("the Project"); and

WHEREAS, the County was designated as the Lead Agency for the Project in the Funding Agreement; and

WHEREAS, as planning for the Project proceeded, it was determined by County and City staffs that the Project could proceed more efficiently if the City were to serve as the Lead Agency for the Project and recommend the Funding Agreement be amended accordingly; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, finds it to be in the public interest to concur in the foregoing recommendation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized to sign on behalf of the City the First Amendment to the Dallas County Capital Improvement Program Funding Agreement substantially in the form attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon final passage.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE DALLAS COUNTY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM PROGRAM FUNDING AGREEMENT

This Amendment is entered into this <u>11th</u> day of <u>July</u>, 2017, to amend the Program Funding Agreement ("FA") between the City of Farmers Branch, Texas (the, "City"), and County of Dallas acting by and through the Dallas County Commissioners Court (the "County") for the implementation of the Westside Trail MCIP Project 20501, hereinafter called (the "Project").

Whereas, Chapter 791 of The Texas Government Code and Texas Transportation Code Article 251 provides authorization for local governments to contract with each other for the performance of governmental functions and services, as well as for joint funding of road or street projects; and

Whereas, pursuant to Dallas County Commissioners Court Order 2011- 1203 dated July 5, 2011, the County acting by and through the Dallas County Commissioners Court, and the City entered into a Master Agreement to jointly fund various street improvement projects; and

Whereas, pursuant to Dallas County Commissioners Court Order No. 2016-0769 dated June 21, 2016 County and City entered into a Program Funding Agreement for the implementation of the Westside Trail MCIP Project 20501; and

Now therefore, this First Amendment is made by and entered into by the City and the County for the mutual consideration stated herein.

I. Purpose

City and County mutually agree to amend said FA in accordance with the terms of the existing Agreement, except as modified below. The purpose of this Agreement is to amend the funding.

II. Amended Provisions

1. Witnesseth section of the FA shall be amended by deleting and replacing the second whereas section, with the following:

City has requested that it be designated as the Lead Agency for the Project and will provide the Project Manager

2. Article III, "Incorporated Documents" of this FA shall be amended by replacing the following attachment:

The Project Scoping Sheets, as shown in Attachment "A"

- 3. Article VI, Agreements, I. City Responsibilities shall be amended by deleting and replacing the following:
 - 1. Paragraph 1 shall read as follows: City will be the Lead Agency for the Project.

2. Paragraph 3 shall read as follows: The Project may require the acquisition of road right-of-way within the alignment which is all real property needed or convenient for roadway purposes as shown in the Project design or right-of-way plans and shall include all real property outside of the designed right-way needed or convenient to the construction, drainage, interface with adjoining streets or alleys, driveways or other access ways or other Project permanent or temporary easements which is approved by City and County. Such right-of-way acquisition shall be the responsibility of City as Lead Agency, and shall be funded as part of Project costs. Such acquisitions will be in the ownership of City as City solely will be responsible for maintenance after construction is completed.

IV. Effect of Amendment

This First Amendment does not change or waive any contractual provisions, clauses or conditions of the original FA, unless otherwise provided for herein. The original FA, including any and all incorporated or referenced documents and any and all exhibits, attachments and amendments that by their terms have been incorporated into any of the foregoing documents, are collectively referred to herein as the FA. All provisions of the FA shall remain in full force and effect throughout the term of the FA and any duly authorized amendments or extensions, including this First Amendment, with the exception of the amended provisions provided herein.

The County of Dallas, State of Texas, has executed this Agreement pursuant to Commissioners Court Order Number ______ and passed on the <u>11th</u> day of <u>July</u>, 2017.

The City of Farmers Branch, State of Texas, has executed this Agreement pursuant to duly authorized City Council Resolution <u>No. 2017-083</u> dated the <u>11th</u> day of <u>July</u>, 2017.
