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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT A GRANT THROUGH THE RIFLE-RESISTANT BODY ARMOR GRANT PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR'S CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice Division ("CJD") of the Office of the Governor has established a grant program to provide funds to assist Texas law enforcement agencies in the purchase of rifleresistant body armor ("the Grant Program"); and

WHEREAS, City Administration recommends accepting the grant that has been awarded to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Farmers Branch to provide for the acceptance of said grant; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. Charles S. Cox, City Manager is designated as an authorized official who is given the apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate a grant, including, but not limited to, a grant under the Rifle-Resistant Body Armor Grant Program ("the Grant Program") administered by the Office of the Governor's Criminal Justice Division ("CJD")

SECTION 2. In the event of loss or misuse of grant funds received by the City pursuant to the Grant Program, all such grant funds will be returned to the CJD.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
