



## **RESOLUTION NO. 2018-017**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, REJECTING THE LOW BID FROM FIVE R CONSTRUCTION AND AWARDING A BID AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH JESKE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$69,240.00 FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF A PARKING LOT ALONG BILL MOSES PARKWAY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, City Administration having identified the need to increase the number of parking spaces along Bill Moses Parkway across from The Grove to accommodate parking needs relating to events held in that area, bids for reconstruction of parking on Bill Moses Parkway ("the Project") were solicited, received, opened, and reviewed; and

**WHEREAS**, in reviewing the bids received for the Project, City Administration has determined the bidder submitting the lowest did not meet adequate references for similar jobs and recommends rejecting said low bid as not being the lowest responsible bid; and

**WHEREAS**, City Administration has determined that Jeske Construction Company is the lowest responsible bidder for the Project, having submitted a bid meeting specification in the amount of \$69,240.00 for the Project, and recommends awarding the bid to Jeske Construction Company; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas finds it to be in the public interest to approve the recommendations of the City Administration.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** Five R Construction is determined to not be the lowest responsible bid and its bid submitted for the Project is hereby rejected.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager is authorized to execute, on behalf of the City of Farmers Branch, a contract with Jeske Construction Company for the Project as set forth in its response to Bid No. 18-05 in the amount of \$69,240.00, and to sign such change orders to said contract as the City Manager deems reasonable, necessary, and in the public interest, which comply with applicable law and City policy and, in the case of an increase in contract price, subject to the availability of current funds.

**SECTION 3.** This resolution shall be effective immediately upon final passage.
