



RESOLUTION NO. 2018-030

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AWARDED A CONTRACT TO FUQUAY, INC. FOR SANITARY SEWER MAIN INSPECTION AND CLEANING THROUGH THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT PURCHASING COOPERATIVE (BUYBOARD); AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has determined that in order to avoid potential breaks and stoppages in the City's sanitary sewer system, the sanitary sewer mains along portions of Rawhide Creek from Webb Chapel Road to Farmers Branch Lane and portions of Cooks Creek from Spring Valley Lane to Denton Drive need to be inspected and cleaned ("the Project"); and

WHEREAS, having reviewed various options, City Administration recommends awarding a unit price contract to Fuquay, Inc. for the Project through the City's cooperative purchasing agreement with the Local Government Purchasing Cooperative ("BuyBoard") and its Contract # 555-18 in the amount \$149,941.77; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas finds it to be in the public interest to approve the recommendation of the City Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized to sign on behalf of the City a unit price contract with Fuquay, Inc. in the amount of up to \$149,941.77 through the City's cooperative purchasing agreement with the Local Government Purchasing Cooperative ("BuyBoard") and its Contract # 555-18 for the Project and to sign such change orders to said contract as the City Manager deems reasonable, necessary, and in the public interest which are in compliance with applicable law and City policy.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon final passage.
