A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, CANVASSING AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH HELD MAY 5, 2018, REGARDING ADOPTION OF AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY CHARTER OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is hereby found and determined that notice of the election was duly given in the form, manner and time required by law, and said election was in all respects legally held and conducted in accordance with applicable laws of the State of Texas and the proceedings calling and governing the holding of such election; and,

WHEREAS, it is imperative to consider the returns of an election held on the May 5, 2018, for the purpose of considering the returns of propositions for the approval of amendments to the City Charter of the City of Farmers Branch; and,
