Continue with Holiday Events as Previously Constructed



Tour of Lights as Previously Executed

- Route beginning at I-35E & Valley View to Denton Drive and continuing through the Historical Park to conclude at Ford Road
- Non-Profit organizations work the gate and provide Santa for donations
- Lights are animated to music played through FM radio
- Estimated Budget: \$283,400





Tree Lighting Event

- Synchronized lighting of tree and displays
- Words from the Mayor/City Council
- Local school entertainment
- Kidzone with holiday themed activities and bounce houses
- Fireworks
- Estimated Budget: \$30,000






2018 Option 2

Create Walking Tour, Santa's Village, and Purchase Outdoor Ice Rink



Walking Tour

- Create a lighted "trail" for guests to walk through the lights
- Path to include: Gussie Field Watterworth Park (Gussie) walking trail, Gussie pavilion & amphitheater, rose gardens, The Grove @ Mustang Crossing and Liberty Plaza
- Create a more interactive experience for guests
- Estimated Budget: \$80,000





Outdoor Skating Rink

- Partner with the StarCenter to purchase an outdoor 100' X 60' outdoor skating rink
- Location:
 - Year 1 grass lot adjacent to the StarCenter
 - Year 2 Liberty Plaza
- City to purchase rink \$130,000
- Stars to purchase dasher boards, provide chillers, skates and staff to operate December 1-January 6
- Revenue sharing arrangement still pending (sponsorship opportunities, public skate, privae skate, group rentals, nightly promotions)
- Three-year commitment





Santa's Village

- Walkable area that could include:
 - Santa's House and Santa
 - Decorative lighting
 - Holiday themed activities
- Located at The Grove at Mustang Crossing
- Estimated Budget: \$75,000
