

Advise

Create and stimulate public interest in the parks and recreation activities of the City.



Report

Make periodic reports to the City Council concerning the work of the Board, and such special reports as may be requested by the City Council.




Identify projects through long-range planning with City Council.

• Timeline: December 1, 2018-January 6, 2019






