



RESOLUTION NO. 2018-080

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF 27 TICKET WRITERS AND RELATED SOFTWARE AND ACCESSORIES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM TYLER TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR THROUGH THE CITY'S COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT WITH NATIONAL JOINT POWERS ALLIANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the handheld electronic ticket writers in use by the Police Department were purchased in 2012, are failing, use operational software that will no longer be supported after 2019, and need to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, City Administration has determined that new ticket writing machines and related software and accessories that best conforms to the City's specifications and needs can be purchased from Tyler Technologies, Inc. through the City's cooperative purchasing with the National Joint Powers Alliance ("NJPA") and recommends such purchase; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, finds it to be in the public interest to accept the recommendation of the City Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized to take such action as necessary on behalf of the City to purchase twenty-seven (27) ticket writers and related software and accessories from Tyler Technologies, Inc, through the City's cooperative purchasing agreement with NJPA in the amount of \$64,533.00 as well as sign any change order(s) related thereto executed in compliance with Texas law and City policy and, if costs increase, subject to the availability of current funds.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
