
Early Voting Locations - October 22 - November 2, 2018

VOTING INFORMATION for the 2018 Bond Election

BOND SUMMARY

On November 6, 2018, the Carrollton-Farmers Branch Independent School District (CFBISD) will hold a bond election for \$350 million to finance the costs of renovations and improvements to all campuses, safety and security, Career and Technical Education (CTE) improvements, fine arts improvements, athletic improvements, and technology.

Citizen Input

Development of the November 2018 bond package involved an in-depth process of information gathering, research and community input by a diverse Citizen's Facility Advisory Committee (CAC) that representing all areas of CFBISD. The Board charged the CAC with assessing and prioritizing the district's current and long-term facility needs and making a recommendation that addresses those needs. The CAC is comprised of 49 members representing all aspects of the School District including 39 parents and community members. The committee members met six times over a six-month period. The CAC made its recommendation to the Board of Trustees on July 26, 2018.

2018 CFBISD Bond Summary

The \$350 million in proposed bond financed improvements include renovations and improvements to all campuses. The bond will also include safety and security, facility-based program improvements, fine arts improvements, athletic improvements, and new technology. Taxes will not increase as a result of the bond.

The bond addresses needs at all CFBISD campuses.
