Overview

• The current streetscape standards are based on Resolutions No. 89-011 and 2007-024, and they have a limited scope covering street name signs, benches, trash receptacles, streetlights, and traffic signal poles. Passed in 1989 and 2007, these resolutions do not cover many of the features that contribute to our streetscape. Streetscape is defined as the visual elements of a street, including the road, adjoining buildings, sidewalks, street furniture, trees and open spaces, etc, that combine to form the street's character.




