RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH KIMLEY-HORN AND ASSOCIATES, INC RELATING TO THE DESIGN OF THE PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS AND MIDWAY ROAD FEASIBILITY STUDY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, City Administration and the City Council have determined that construction of controlled pedestrian crossings within the central area of the City as well as preparation of a feasibility study relating to controlled pedestrian crossings on Midway Road (the "Crossing Project") will benefit the City's residents; and

WHEREAS, City Administration, having determined that the firm of Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. is qualified to perform the Crossing Project and has negotiated an agreement with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. to provide such professional engineering and survey services pursuant to costs for such services that City Administration has determined are fair and reasonable; and

WHEREAS, City Administration recommends that an agreement with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. be approved; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, finds it to be in the public interest to concur in the above recommendation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute on behalf of the City an agreement with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for professional engineering and surveying services for the preparation of the Crossing Project in an amount not to exceed \$418,700.00. Furthermore, subject to applicable state law, city policies, and in the availability of funds in the City's budget for such purposes, the City Manager is authorized to agree to such additional services as he deems reasonable and necessary and in the best interest of the City.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its approval.
