A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS **BRANCH**, TEXAS AWARDING BIDS AND AUTHORIZING CONTRACTS FOR VARIOUS TRADES AND WORK RELATED TO CONSTRUCTION OF PHASE ONE OF CENTER PROVIDING THE SERVICE **PROJECT:** AN **EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, City Administration, with the assistance on the City's construction manager, sought and obtained bids for various trades, work, equipment, and materials, related to construction of phase one of the Service Center Project ("the Project"); and

WHEREAS, having determined that the various companies identified in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein, have submitted the lowest most qualified bid for the various portions of the Project identified on Exhibit "A," City Administration recommends contracts for the work identified on Exhibit "A" be awarded to the respective entities listed on Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas finds it to be in the public interest to accept the recommendation of the City Administration and award the above-described contracts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate and sign on behalf of the City contracts with the entities identified in Exhibit "A," attached hereto, to provide the work, materials, equipment, and/or supplies identified on Exhibit "A" for the amounts set forth in Exhibit "A", as well as sign any change order(s) related thereto executed in compliance with Texas law and City policy and upon approval as to form of the contract and/or change orders by the City Attorney.

SECTION 2. In the event any one or more of the entities identified in Exhibit "A" fail to timely provide any required bonds or insurance or otherwise fail to timely execute a contract with the City as authorized, the City Manager shall be authorized to negotiate and sign a contract with the entity submitting the second lowest and most qualified bid for said work, supplies, materials or equipment.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
