## **RESOLUTION NO. 2019-059**



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, RATIFYING THE ACTS OF THE CITY MANAGER AND AUTHORIZING EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO A PIERCE QUANTUM FIRE TRUCK BY SIDDONS-MARTIN EMERGENCY GROUP; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, in route to a call, a water pump transfer case on City Unit 42190, a 2005 Pierce Ouantum Fire Truck, failed, causing additional damage to the vehicle; and

**WHEREAS,** in order to prevent a shortage of available equipment to fight fires within the City should other equipment unexpectedly fail and become unavailable, the City Manager authorized Siddons-Martin Emergency Group to repair City Unity 42190 for an estimated cost of \$74,277.37; and

**WHEREAS**, finding that the repairs authorized by the City Manager were necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the City's resident and are necessary as the result of unforeseen damage to public equipment, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, finds it to be in the public interest to ratify and affirm the above acts of the City Manager;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The acts of the City Manager authorizing and approving payment in the amount of \$74,277.37 to Siddons-Martin Emergency Group for repairs to City Unit 42190 are hereby ratified and approved by the City Council as if originally approved by the City Council prior to the City Manager having performed such acts.

**SECTION 2.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
