




## Woven Health Clinic PREVENT Disease NOW!



#### 2018 Outcomes:

52% of Depression Patients in Remission86% of Hypertension Patients Controlled54% of Diabetic Patients Controlled14% of Pre-Diabetic Patients now Normal

Cost Per Patient: \$500 per patient/per year for health services + \$500 per patient/per year In Kind Pharmaceuticals and Vaccines.





# **Woven Health Clinic**

2018-2019 Accomplishments in Farmers Branch

- In 2018, held four Walk with a Doc Events in Farmers Branch Parks (Raw Hide Park) in February, March, June and October, attended by over 120 people.
- In March of 2018, held a Zumba Class and a Stretching Class attended by 50 people.
- In 2019, held four Healthy Cooking Classes attended by over 100 people in January, February, March and April.





## **Woven Health Clinic**

2018-2019 Accomplishments

- Expanded Clinic Space
  - Added a 1,000 square feet and held a ribbon cutting event in September 2018
  - Increased capacity to see more patients by 35%.
- Held our first, awards/fundraising luncheon in November 2018.
  - Raised \$40,000
  - Recognized Carrollton-Farmers Branch ISD and Children's Health for their community impact with their Telemedicine Behavioral Health and Primary Care program.

# Status of Health Care in North Texas
