



RESOLUTION NO. 2019-65

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR A SOLAR FEASIBILITY STUDY OF CITY FACILITIES WITH SHOR POWER; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has expressed an interest in assessing options for reducing electricity-related costs prior to the expiration of the City's current electrical purchase contract on September 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, after soliciting, receiving, and reviewing responses to a Request for Qualifications for solar feasibility assessment services, City Administration determined that Shor Power is the most qualified to provide such professional services for a fair and reasonable fee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the public interest to concur in the opinion of City Administration and to enter into a professional services agreement with Shor Power for such professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized to negotiate and sign on behalf of the City a professional services agreement with Shor Power to prepare a feasibility study of City facilities for a fee in the amount of \$49,480.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
