**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR DEVELOPMENT REPLACEMENT WATER SUPPLY WELL BID DOCUMENT, FIELD INSPECTION, DATA ANALYSIS WITH WEEGAR-EIDE & ASSOCIATES, LLC; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has agreed to construct a water production well to be founded in the Trinity Aquifer as part of a settlement agreement with the Town of Addison, Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds it to be in the public interest to enter into a professional services agreement with Weegar-Eide & Associates, LLC for such professional services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute on behalf of the City a professional services agreement with Weegar-Eide & Associates, LLC to prepare Development Replacement Water Supply Well Bid Document, Field Inspection, Data Analysis, and Report for a fee in the amount of \$351,360.

**SECTION 2.** This resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
