

Contract with Weegar-Eide & Associates LLC

For the design and construction of a groundwater production well



Background

- The City of Farmers Branch and the Town of Addison reached a settlement agreement regarding a dispute over the Town's water rights permit.
- The City of Farmers Branch has agreed to install, operate, and maintain a water well founded in the Trinity Aquifer to provide make up water for evaporative losses attributed to the alteration of the channel of Farmers Branch Creek through the Vitruvian development in the Town of Addison.
- The Trinity Aquifer is approximately 1,500 to 2,000 feet below ground surface elevation.
- The City of Farmers Branch will pay for the well construction, piping, and other well accessories.
- The Town of Addison will pay for the well pad design and construction



Weegar-Eide Services

- 1. Well pad and infrastructure design and bid document preparation,
- 2. Bid review,
- 3. Preconstruction project coordination,
- 4. Field inspection of site work and data collection, and
- 5. Analyze the field data and prepare project report.
- The contract also has a contingency line item due to unknown regulatory issues and potential weather delays due to construction and drilling occurring in the winter and spring months.
- The not-to-exceed limit of the contract \$351,360. The Town of Addison will reimburse the City for the cost of the well pad design (estimated \$114,000).
