RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH URBAN ENGINEERING GROUP INC. FOR PROESSIONAL ENGINEERING AND SURVEYINGK RELATING TO THE DESIGN, BIDDING, AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE TRAIL IMPROVEMENTS - SIDEWALK CONNECTIVITY AND EXPANSION PROJECT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, City Administration and the City Council have determined that improvements to the City's system of sidewalks, will benefit the City's residents, specifically along the following street segments: (i) Valley View Lane from Mt. Castle Drive to Marsh Lane; (ii) Bee Street from Valley View to Valwood Parkway; (iii) Squire Place from Denton Drive to Bee Street and Utility Easement; (iv) Josey Lane from IH635 to Rawhide Parkway; (5) Templeton Trail from Joe Ratliff Walkway to Valley View Lane; and (vi) Ford Road from Christian Parkway to the median crossing for the Historical Park ("the Project"); and

WHEREAS, City Administration, having received and reviewed statements of qualifications from various engineering firms, finds the firm of Urban Engineering Group, Inc. ("UEG"), is qualified to perform the professional services necessary for the preparation of the design, bidding, and construction documents and related surveying services related to the Project and has negotiated an agreement with UEG to provide such professional engineering and survey services pursuant to fees that are fair and reasonable; and

WHEREAS, City Administration recommends that an agreement with UEG be approved; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, finds it to be in the public interest to concur in the above recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute on behalf of the City an agreement with Urban Engineering Group, Inc. for professional engineering and surveying services for the Project in the amount of \$436,795.00, and subject to applicable state law, city policies, and in event of an increase in contract price, the availability of funds in the City's budget for such purposes, the City Manager is authorized to agree to such additional services as he deems reasonable and necessary and in the best interest of the City.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon its approval.
