RESOLUTION NO. 2019-179



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH O'BRIEN & ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES RELATING TO THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF AN EVENT CENTER AT THE FARMERS BRANCH HISTORICAL PARK; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to build at the Farmers Branch Historical Park a new barntype structure that will serve as an event center for catered affairs and weddings and a museum ("the Project"); and

WHEREAS, based on prior experience and review of qualifications, City Administration has determined that O'Brien & Associates, Inc. is the most qualified to provide professional architectural services related to the design and construction of the Project, and has proceeded to negotiate a professional services agreement with O'Brien & Associates, Inc. for architectural services related to the Project for a fee that is determined to be fair and reasonable; and

WHEREAS, City Administration recommends entering into the proposed professional services agreement with O'Brien & Associates, Inc. for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch finds it in the public interest to concur in the above recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized to negotiate and execute on behalf of the City a professional services agreement with O'Brien & Associates, Inc. to provide architectural services relating to the design and construction of the Project for a fee not to exceed the amount of \$125,000.00.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
