Senior Property Tax Exemptions

Options for Consideration



CURRENT STATE

Senior Exemption = \$65,000

Taxpayer Savings = \$389.68

City Revenue Loss = \$883,014



INCREASE \$5,000

Senior Exemption = \$70,000

Taxpayer Savings = \$419.65

(\$29.97 of incremental savings or about a 1 cent reduction in tax rate)

City Revenue Loss = \$950.938 (\$67,925 of incremental lost

revenue)



INCREASE \$10,000

Senior Exemption = \$75,000

Taxpayer Savings = \$449.63

(\$59.95 of incremental savings or about a 2.5 cent reduction in tax rate)

City Revenue Loss = \$1,018,862 (\$135,848 of incremental lost revenue)



INCREASE \$20,000

Senior Exemption = \$85,000

Taxpayer Savings = \$509.58

(\$119.90 of incremental savings or about a 5 cent reduction in tax rate)

City Revenue Loss = \$1,154,710

(\$271,696 of incremental lost revenue)

\$1,000 in additional Senior Property Tax Exemption is about \$6 in savings to the tax payer.

\$1.000 in additional Senior Property Tax Exemption is about **\$13,600 in lost** revenue to the City.

There are currently 2.266 parcels with over 65 exemptions.

A listing of Area City Tax **Rates and Certain Exemptions** for the 2019 Tax Year has been provided.

Any change to property tax exemptions must be adopted by ordinance and provided to DCAD by July 1st.



Note: All calculations based on average property value of \$233,681 and includes the 20% homestead exemption which reduces property taxes due on the average valued property by \$280, which is equal to an 11 cent reduction in rate.
