Mission & Vision



• <u>Mission</u>- To promote the independence and well-being of older adults in our community through health, wellness, educational, cultural, and recreational services.

 <u>Vision</u>- To provide a friendly and active environment with connections through programs and services for older adults within the Farmers Branch community.

Meetings & Participation



- Monthly meetings conducted through Zoom with the first in-person meeting being held on 4/8/2021.
- All meetings have met quorum and majority attendance.
- Board members make phone calls to members each week and help inform via Facebook and Nextdoor in regards to activities or events.
- During the closure, board members informed facility members of alternative program locations, on-line activities, and shared information leading up to the facility re-opening.

Facility Re-opening Efforts



- On March 15, 2021 The Branch Connection re-opened its doors after being closed for a full year due to COVID-19.
- The first phase of the re-opening allowed for limited fitness and recreation classes.
- The second phase offered full use of the facility as long as patrons complied with mask requirements, social distancing, and had received a Covid-19 vaccination at least 14 days prior to entering the facility.
- Attendance levels have steadily increased 71% since reopening in March.
- In an effort to increase membership levels, several membership campaigns and community outreach efforts are underway.

Examples of Success



Memberships and Programs:

- Virtual and distanced programming since October 2020 has served 5,694 program participants.
- In-person events have included Veteran's Day, Bumper Bingo, Drive-In Movie, along with several offsite programs.
- With many senior centers still closed, The Branch Connection is thriving with thirty new memberships sold since re-opening.
- All programming has returned to in-person with modified options or virtual components for those unable to attend in person. Large events such as the monthly breakfast, bingo, and weekly dances will return in a phased approach as Covid cases continue to drop.


Board Accomplishments
