



## ORDINANCE NO. 3692

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 2 “ADMINISTRATION” ARTICLE II “BOARDS, COMMITTEES, AND COMMISSIONS” DIVISION 9A BY AMENDING THE PURPOSE AND AUTHORITY OF THE ARTS AND CULTURE COMMITTEE; PROVIDING FOR A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.** The Code of Ordinances of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, be and the same is hereby amended by amending Chapter 2 “Administration” Article II “Boards and Commissions” in part by amending Division 9A of the Code of Ordinances by amending Section 2-257(a) to amend the purpose and authority of the Arts and Culture Committee to read as follows:

**“Sec. 2-257. Purpose and Authority.**

- (a) The purpose and authority of the Committee shall be to:
  - (1) study, consider and make recommendations to the City Council regarding the establishment of a public art program;
  - (2) develop and recommend to the City Council programs that promote the general community interest, awareness, and participation in a Public Art program, including but not limited to the donation of artwork to be accepted as Public Art;
  - (3) recommend amendments to the public art program from time to time; and
  - (4) perform such other tasks and projects as may from time to time be assigned to the Committee by the City Council.

**SECTION 2.** All provisions of the ordinances of the City of Farmers Branch in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be, and the same are hereby, repealed, and all other provisions of the ordinances of the City of Farmers Branch not in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3.** Should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this Ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part so

decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of the Code of Ordinances as a whole.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law and charter in such cases provide.
