



RESOLUTION NO. 2021-132

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF AN ELEVATED LANDFILL GAS FLARE, BLOWER, AND ASSOCIATED EQUIPMENT FOR THE LANDFILL GAS COLLECTION SYSTEM AT CAMELOT LANDFILL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the continued expansion of the landfill gas collection system at the City's Camelot Landfill ("the Collection System") has resulted in the capacity of the existing gas flare, blower, and associated equipment becoming inadequate; and

WHEREAS, the City's consultant, Weaver Consultants Group, recommends the purchase and installation of a larger capacity gas flare and related equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Collection System consists largely of equipment and systems manufactured by John Zink Company, LLC or related companies; and

WHEREAS, to ensure compatibility with the existing components of the Collection System, City staff recommends purchasing a larger gas flare and related system from John Zink Company, LLC, has obtained a proposal from said company for such equipment, and recommends the purchase of such equipment; and

WHEREAS, the procurement of a larger capacity gas flare and related equipment and incorporation of same into the Collection System is necessary for the protection of the City's residents and residents located within the vicinity of the Camelot Landfill; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the public interest to make the above-described purchase in accordance with the foregoing recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is authorized to purchase on behalf of the City an elevated gas flare, blower, and related equipment for the landfill gas collection system at Camelot Landfill from John Zink Company, LLC for an amount not to exceed \$161,000.00 in accordance with John Zink Proposal No. 202005-130253-REV3, a copy of which is on file in the Office of City Secretary and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
