## **RESOLUTION NO. 2021-141**



A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR GIS SOFTWARE LICENSING AND MAINTENANCE WITH ENVIRONMENTAL SYSTEMS RESEARCH INSTITUTE (ESRI) FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT OF \$115,500.00; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City has for many years satisfactorily used software licensed from Environmental Systems Research Institute ("ESRI") in operating the City's Geographical Information System ("GIS") applications as well as other applications used to provide both external and internal services for the City; and

WHEREAS, the current software licenses purchased from ESRI are due to expire; and

**WHEREAS**, there being no other vendor available who is able to provide similar software needs, City Administration recommends that the various license agreement with ESRI be renewed for a term of three years; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Farmers Branch, Texas, finds it to be in the public interest to concur in the above recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FARMERS BRANCH, TEXAS THAT:

**SECTION 1**. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take such action and enter such agreements necessary to renew the various software licenses with ESRI for a term of three years for a license fee in the amount of \$38,500.00 per year (i.e., a total of \$115,500), such payments for fiscal years following the 2021-2022 being subject to appropriation of current funds in such future fiscal years.

**SECTION 2**. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
