Activities include family entertainment at the stage, bounce houses, photo buttons, Boo-ville area, carnival games, concessions, and more! The Haunted Hedge will be open from sunset until 10 p.m. Boo Passes, which give Farmers Branch residents free entry, will be available in advance at select City facilities. Residents without a Boo Pass can still get in free with proof of residency. Non-resident admission for ages 4 and up is \$5 per person. Carnival Game Booth Reservation Details:

- \$35 non-refundable fee includes use of a 10' x 10' tent, access to electricity, and the opportunity to promote your organization to thousands of event attendees.
- You provide the game, equipment, supplies, volunteers/staff, etc.
- Charge \$.25-1.00 to play a game.
- Your organization keeps all the money raised.

Game booths are limited and reserved on a first-come, first-served basis. Limit one game booth per organization. Game booths require preapproval to avoid duplicate games. The organization's contact person will be notified when the reservation is confirmed or if the organization is placed on a waiting list.

Volunteers with an organization must be at least 16 years of age. Volunteers are encouraged to dress in costume. Organizations must be able to operate the game booth the entirety of the event. Game booths may not shut down early without approval from the Event Coordinator or another authorized City staff member.
