### **Consider approving Resolution No. 2019-038 adopting the City's Water Conservation Plan; and take appropriate action**

#### BACKGROUND:

The City of Farmers Branch has a water conservation plan and a drought contingency plan, as required by the Texas Water Code. The objectives of a water conservation plan are to reduce water consumption (gallons per capita per day) basis and improve the efficiency in the use of water. The objective of a drought contingency plan is to conserve the available water supply in times of drought and emergency.

#### DISCUSSION:

Texas Water Code further requires that retail public water suppliers with more than 3,300 connections develop and submit an updated and revised water conservation plan to the Texas Water Development Board every five years. The plan is based on specific targets and goals developed by the City.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

No Financial Impact.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

City Administration recommends approval of Resolution No. 2019-038 adopting an updated and revised water conservation plan.

#### ACTIONS:
